Included are 5 files with different ratios. Each file is 1 high res JPG image at 300 dpi.

- A 4x5 ratio file for printing sizes: 4"x5", 8"x10", 16"x20"
- A 3x4 ratio file for printing sizes: 6"x8", 9"x12", 12"x16", 18"x24"
- A 2x3 ratio file for printing sizes: 4"x6", 6"x9", 8"x12", 10"x15", 12"x18", 16"x24", 20"x30", 24"x36"
- An international paper size file for printing sizes: 5"x7", A5, A4, A3, A2, A1

Printing Options:

- an at-home color printer
- office supply stores like Staples or Fedex
- online printing shops like vistaprint.com or shutterfly.com
- a local, professional printing shop
